Sub: Permission matter of R.N. Kapoor Memorial Homoeopathic Medical College, Indore-Dewas, By pass Road, Gram Arandia, Post Jhalaria, Indore 452016 for continuing admissions in (1- BHMS) course with 100 seats for the academic year 2022-23 – regarding

Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, as per NCH Act 2020 and its relevant regulations.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-1 proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

On careful examination of the hearing report conducted dated 15/11/2022 at 2:00 P.M, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed following shortfalls:-

1. Hospital facilities:-

- IPD- Average Bed Occupancy per day-11.01% against the requirement of 30% as per MSR 2013.

2. Teaching Department:-

- In Anatomy Department cadaver is not available as they have applied for anatomy act in 2021.

3. Teaching faculty: -

Guest faculty:-The College has provided 12 guest faculties but only 08 are eligible. Discrepancies are as follows:-

- Dr. shilpi jain - Guest Reader-pathology- previous experience as guest lecturer is provided which is not a valid post as per MSR 2013.
- Dr. Mahendra Kumar Sharma- Guest Reader-FMT previous experience provided as guest lecturer which is not a post as per MSR 2013.
- Dr. Amit Kumar- Guest Reader- Medicine – previous teaching experience as lecturer not fulfilling.
- Dr. Yamini Sonvane- Guest Reader- Repertory-previous experience as guest lecturer is provided which is not a valid post as per MSR 2013.

4. Miscellaneous:-

- Form-16 of 19 teaching staff is provided but 18 are not from traces portal.

- Acquittance of 22 staff only provided.

After considering the provisions of NCH Act,2020 and its relevant regulations **Conditional Permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to R.N. Kapoor Memorial Homoeopathic Medical College, Indore-Dewas, By pass Road, Gram Arandia, Post Jhalaria, Indore 452016 for continuing admissions in 1- BHMS course with 100 seats for the academic year 2022- 23.**

Though due to Covid situation IPD/OPD status are not considered for permission process this needs to be tremendously enhanced. You are required to take necessary measures for improvement of OPD/IPD and fulfillment of the deficiencies and the status of the same shall be apprised to MARBH within 3 months from the date of issue of this letter. The college shall submit the continuance of affiliation certificate from the University, issued after the last University inspection.

All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under.

The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

The college has to comply with the full requirements as per NCH Act, 2020 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed, has to be rectified within 30 days' time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance.
