- Emoluments & benefits:**
The selected candidates would be paid a consolidated pay of Rs. 60,000/- p.m. for the one year of training.
- Education Qualification (as on 01.01.2023)**
Candidate must possess the minimum qualification as listed in the table below from a recognized University or any equivalent qualification recognized as such by Central Government. Candidates should possess certificate in proof of passing the qualifying examination as on 01.01.2023 and have to ensure the following :
 - Educational qualification should be from a University/Institution/Board recognized by Govt. of India/approved by Govt. Regulatory Bodies and the result should have been declared on or before 01.01.2023
 - The candidate must possess valid mark-sheet/Degree Certificate of the necessary qualification as on 01.01.2023
 - Percentage marks shall be arrived at by dividing the total marks obtained by the candidate in all the subjects in all the semester(s)/ year(s) by aggregate maximum marks in all the subjects irrespective of Honours / optional / additional optional subject, if any. This will be applicable for those Universities also where class / grade is decided on basis of Honours marks only. The fraction of percentage so arrived will be ignored i.e. 59.99% will be treated as less than 60% and the fraction of percentage so arrived i.e. 54.99% will be treated as less than 55%.
 - Where CGPA/OGPA are awarded, the candidate will have to produce a certificate issued by the appropriate authority inter alia stating the norms of the University regarding conversion of grade into percentage and the percentage of marks scored by the candidate in terms of norms.

Minimum Educational Qualifications as on 01.01.2023 :
The candidate should apply for the following Discipline:

General	Graduate in Arts/Science/Commerce/Agriculture/Horticulture/Animal Husbandry/Management/Statistics/HR/Others with 60% marks (55 % marks for SC/ST).

Note: The candidate applying must possess Computer efficiency and proficiency of Regional Local language.

Minimum Age: 21 years &
Maximum Age: 30 years
i.e. a candidate must have been born not earlier than 1st January 1993 and not later than 31st December 2001 (both dates inclusive).
