

ADMISSION OF STUDENT

The University shall follow the normal admission process to all courses, specified as below: -

- The University will issue the admission notification on the University's website, in newspapers, notice board of the University and in other publicity media before the
- commencement of new academic session.
 List of candidate provisionally selected shortlisted for admission/shortlisted will be displayed on the notice board of University and University's website. Also, the students will be informed individually regarding their admission.
- The candidates whose results of qualifying exams are awaited can also apply, and they will be admitted provisionally. Such candidate, however, must produce the previous year's mark sheet, school/college certificate as a proof of fulfilling required eligible criteria before the due date, failing which, the provisional admission cannot be granted. The candidate so admitted shall have to present mark sheet of the qualifying examination within a month of the due date of admission, failing which the provisional admission shall be cancelled.
- The application form may be rejected due to any of the following reasons:
 (I) The candidate does not fulfill the eligibility conditions.

 - (ii) The candidate has been debarred on disciplinary grounds from any colleges/University/Institution.

 - (iii)The prescribed fee is not paid.
 (iv) The application form is not signed by the candidate and his/her parent/guardian,
 - wherever required.
 (v) Required documents for admission are not enclosed.
- Enrollment will be assigned to the student by the University after verification & submission of all required documents/fees.
- Admission rules as framed by the University shall be applicable for all admission from time to time and all the decisions shall be final.
- A student shall be enrolled as a member of an institute as soon as he/she is admitted by the Head of the Institution and has paid the prescribed fees.
- A student seeking admission to an Institution after the commencement of the Session shall be required to pay tuition fee from July of the year/or as directed by Academic Council of the University
- The Head of the Institute may permit a student to change his/her optional subject for a
- course with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor, within 30days of start of the course. Reservation to SC/ST/Other categories students shall be observed as per rules of Government of M.P. Guidelines from time to time, Concessions/Scholarship to SC/ST/Other Category candidates relaxation shall be given as per Government of M.P. Guidelines
- from time to time and as decided by Board of Management of University. The fees deposited by the candidate are is non-refundable.
- For better support to the student in conjunction with the traditional approaches, modern approaches based on information and communication technologies for teaching/learning will be adopted. Wires may include online teaching-learning, material availability, webcasting, Podcasting, Online chatting with teachers, online discussion forms etc. If the admitted candidate after admission voluntarily ask for cancellation of admission and
- refund of fees. He/She will be held responsible for spoiling one seat of the program & will be liable to pay fees of entire tenure of program than only the original documents T.C. & Migration shall be granted.
- What ever fees is submitted by the student in the time of registration/college fees will not be refunded if the student cancel the admission after due date

B. Attendance & Leave of Absence

- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each period. Late comers shall enter classrooms only with the permission of the teacher.
- Students who leave class-rooms after roll call without the permission of the teacher are liable to punishment.
- 3. Impersonation at roll call will be considered as serious offence.
- Application for leave of absence for more than 4 days due to illness should be supported by medical certificates.
- Students absenting the mselves from the college for more than fifteen consecutive working days without satisfactory explanation will have their names removed from the roll and treated as temporary removal.
- A student sent out from the class by a teacher shall lose the attendance for the duration he is out.
- Disciplinary action including removal from the rolls will be taken against those who repeatedly absent themselves on insufficient grounds.
- A student requiring leave for a day or a part of a day should apply for tit to the director or to the teacher authorized by him and get his counter signature and submit the form in the college
- office. Such application should be submitted on the very of his/her return to the college.

 9. The responsibility of making sure that a student has earned the required minimum percentage of attendance (75% for the sem) rests entirely upon the student. The University insists on a minimum of 75% attendance during the course of instruction for permitting students to take the examination. The College expects a much higher percentage of attendance than the minimum 75% required by the University.

RULES & REGULATIONS

A. Conduct and Discipline of students

- It shall be the bound duty of every student to abide by the rules and regulations of the College / University, and to conduct him/her self with discipline and decorum in all places and under all circumstances
- Every student shall attend classes regularly and punctually and shall refrain from any action that may disturb the smooth working of the College / University. Students shall be clean and decorous in dress, language and behavior.
- Smoking, use of alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited in the College / University premises. Students shall not enter the College / University drunk.
 Every student shall greet the members of the teaching staff on the occasion of first
- meeting them within the college / university premises and whenever he meets them in public
- When a teacher enters a class-room, the students shall rise and remain standing till they are directed to sit or the teacher takes his seat.
- When classes are in session, students shall not enter or leave the class rooms without the prior permission of the teachers concerned.
- Students who may be free during class-time shall not loiter on the Veranda or on the premises of the college / university. During such time they are to be in the Library.
- Every student shall handle college / university property with care and shall do everything in his power to preserve cleanliness and tidiness of the furniture, building and the premises. Students shall not disfigure the walls, doors, windows, furniture etc. with bills, engraving etc.
- The loss or damage or disfigurement caused to the college / university articles will be made good by realising double the loss or damages so incurred from the concerned students or through a collective fine covering all the students.




